We are writing with reference to a proposed eviction notice served on Ms Gillian McCarthy of The Stop Gap, Shepton Montague, Somerset.

We are concerned about the implications of the eviction regarding Ms McCarthy's health.

Ms McCarthy is disabled & suffers from Multiple Chemical Sensitivity (MCS). We understand that MCS requires complex diagnostic & specialist treatment, both of which she is still awaiting.

Along with her present fragile state of health we are concerned that without treatment & the right facilities the eviction may have a disastrous effect on Ms McCarthy's health & possibly prove fatal.

We hope this letter may bring her plight to your attention & that the correct procedures & facilities be made available if the eviction is still to be considered.

We respectfully ask that you might consider interceding on her behalf in whatever way you feel appropriate & thank you for your support.
